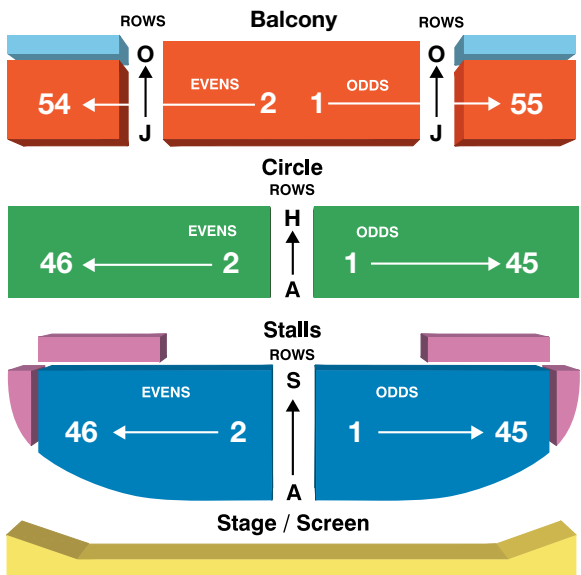
RESTORATION DONATION
